

TRINITY SUNDAY

This Sunday about 55 of our younger brothers and sisters complete their initiation into the Church as they receive Our Lord in Holy Communion for the first time. No more will they come with their arms crossed asking a blessing of the minister distributing Holy Communion. Now they come to receive Our Lord either on their hands or on their tongues.

Their initiation began when their parents presented them for baptism on the strength of the parents' faith. Earlier this year Archbishop Coleridge

confirmed the faith they had and sealed them with the gift of the Spirit as he anointed them the oil of Chrism which last touched their heads when they were infants. The oil disappeared into their skin leaving a softness to touch and an unusual fragrance to savour. The Spirit which we could not see, likewise disappeared into them but makes its presence visible when we see forbearance, love, mercy, gentleness, forgiveness flower in their words and deeds.

As they share in the Eucharist most fully for the first time by eating and drinking the food given us by Jesus in which He gives us himself they rejoice that this day has arrived. The time of preparation is over. Now they share with us in a common unity that is holy - Holy Communion. They welcome Our Lord into themselves and being one with Him they share the unity, the oneness Jesus has with the Father in the power of the Holy Spirit. They find themselves at home with the Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Unlike baptism and confirmation that are only celebrated once, sharing Holy Communion is to be celebrated as often as possible. We need this heavenly food for us to grow strong in our faith and work as apostles. As we eat regularly to maintain good physical health, we eat regularly at Eucharist to maintain good Christian spiritual health. We do this especially on Sundays, the day Jesus put death into perspective by His resurrection, but we can celebrate Eucharist during the week.

We do rejoice with our young friends. We rejoice with parents, godparents and family as this part of their faith life begins. We pray that their love for Jesus will grow daily and that they will be known as people who love Him, believe in Him and speak and act as He did.

ST AGATHA'S HOSPITALITY MINISTRY. The Parish Pastoral Council is seeking to establish within the St Agatha's Parish a Hospitality Ministry. 
CHRISTIFIDELES LAICI - PARTICIPATION OF LAY PEOPLE IN THE CHURCH
