

FAITH IN CHRIST - ROSE COLOURED GLASSES OR CORRECTIVE LENSES

I am short sighted. My left eye is more affected than my right. My routine visit to the optometrist revealed more deterioration requiring new lenses in my glasses. I recalled the day when, aged 17, I looked at my surroundings for the first time wearing glasses. What struck me was that trees had individual leaves. It was not just a mass of green but hundreds, thousands of separate leaves. Each leaf stood out clearly and distinctly.

This experience as a teenager surfaced unexpectedly as I was reflecting on the lines in today's first reading which are picked up in the gospel: the people that walked in darkness has seen a great light; on those who dwell in the land (of death) and shadow of death a light has dawned. Of course, St Matthew with his love of seeing prophecies fulfilled saw Jesus appearing in public in the north of the country where Jesus mingled with gentile neighbours as the great light Isaiah, the prophet, said would come.

We need light to see but does our commitment to our faith in Jesus, the light, help us see the world as it is or an unreal one that we wish did exist? Do people like us see the world with rose coloured glasses or with corrective lenses?

As you would expect I see the faith as something more like corrective lenses. The world, people, are seen with clarity. There is no general mass of people like the green of the trees I saw years ago. With the eyes of faith, I see individual people with all their distinctive individuality. I see what is beautiful and appealing. I see what is ugly and repelling.

This is the world Jesus has called us to go into as he did with the first disciples. It is the world as it is now not how we might wish it to be or how it will be when recreated by Christ at the end of time. Christ's disciples touch this world with his compassion, wisdom and love so even now people are rescued, saved, from danger and able to live more fully.

A special emphasis is placed on helping parents as well as the disabled with their personal, spiritual and social lives. Although based on Catholic beliefs, it is ecumenical and all members and people with disabilities are welcome. The members of the Little King's Movement commit themselves to bringing to people with disabilities a sense of worth, a sense of being valued and a sense of being loved. There are no Government subsidies, and most activities are voluntary. All activities for our disabled friends are free of charge. This is the major fund raiser for the year. In previous years the Parish has been very generous even in the most difficult financial times, for which the Movement is most grateful.
