Be holy, be perfect!

To modern ears, these words "be holy" (first reading), "be perfect" (gospel) sound like an invitation to a breakdown, more so the second group than the first. The first "Be holy" our secular society tells us is at best an unattainable ideal and at worst a flight from reality and an ideal that no one with their feet firmly planted on the ground would want to aspire to. The second about perfection is quickly rejected as recipe for psychological harm on a grand scale.

Yet both are offered to us by God as words God wants us to hear, embrace and live by. What we need to do constantly as we listen to the readings from the Word of God that form the first part of every mass is to listen with the conviction that God loves us and wants what is best for us. If we make this our starting point then we focus our attention on how do these words give us what is best for us.

The command to be holy is unpackaged by speaking of rejecting hatred, vengeance and grudges and actively loving your neighbour as you love yourself. Hatred, vengeance and grudges are bad news for those who surrender themselves to such things because those who do, lock themselves into living in the past when the acts that sparked the hatred took place. Think of times when you held a grudge. You have to recall the event and convince yourself that holding the grudge is the right thing to do, no matter that you may never act on the grudge and actually do harm to one who hurt you. The past event so obsesses us that we lose touch with the present.

Our happiness lies with committing ourselves to loving our neighbour and Jesus takes it even further when he says that we are to love even those who do not have our best interests at heart, enemies. Rather than surrender ourselves to hatred, vengeance and getting even, we genuinely pray for those who deliberately make life difficult for us. This is no half-hearted prayer but from the heart, asking God to help your persecutor receive the love God has for him or her. Jesus uses the image of the sun shining on everyone as a way to grasp how God loves, wants what is best for good and bad people alike.

We are made in the image of God and our human nature will be perfect only when we commit ourselves to relating with all in our personal worlds in the same way. Voices inside us may say that is a stupid idea but when we undertake such commitment we see that it is anything but stupid. Cycles of violence, getting even, are broken only when we do what God commands. Let us pray for each other this week to do what Jesus says.


