> Readings - Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time - 16 February 2014 1st Reading: Sirach 15:15-20; 2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:6-10; Gospel: Matthew 5:17-37





Archaeological discoveries have revealed human beings different from ourselves. They have been given names such as Cro-Magnon and Neanderthal. At times they have been called cave men because of drawings and paintings found on cave walls where they lived. Those who study these things refer to modern humanity as homo sapiens highlighting our ability to reason. In these studies homo sapiens is seen as higher up the tree of human development than the others.

If there has been this development, a reasonable question is where to from here? For those who enjoyed the X-men film series they are acquainted with homo superior which is what the mutant humans fighting non-mutant humans called those without the extraordinary powers the mutants possessed. Other fiction writers have described developments where humans could be transformed so they could fly like birds or swim in the oceans like fish having been given wings or gills.

These stories are works of fiction which may or may not come to pass. What we have right under our noses and fail to see is the person of Jesus. He is the first of many brothers and sisters. He is what humanity is growing to be. Appearing at a particular moment in history he comes to us as the destination of human development. He is what a perfect human being looks like. He is the full flowering of humanity.

What then do we need to do to ensure this development? In the writings we hold as sacred are the directions to guide us. St Matthew portrays Jesus as a new Moses who came down from the mountain with the words God spoke for the development of the people God called My people. Those words we know as the ten commandments. The words Jesus spoke in what we call the sermon on the mount are the eight beatitudes. Each beatitude starts that those who allow themselves to be transformed in the way described are "blessed" or "happy". To be poor in spirit, meek, pure of heart, justice seeking and the like are the flowering of the new humanity. And they are not just for consumption and use by believers but are for the whole race in its quest for happiness and fulfilment.

Go home and read the whole sermon with the thought in mind: this is what I am to become. This is what the whole race will become in the fullness of time


