Dear sisters and brothers,

I celebrated my 18th anniversary of ordination during this past week. These moments mark a progression, but they are also occasions of reflection. These 18 years have taken me in directions I never dreamed when I was ordained. And like any journey of life, there have been highs and lows, successes and failures. These are all part of the rich texture of life.

Gratefulness is one of the cornerstones of faith. On occasions like anniversaries or birthdays, as people of faith, we are called to recognise the blessings that come to us as gifts from God. Indeed, true gratefulness is the ability to say, "I am grateful for everything – even the not so good stuff!" To recognise everything as 'gift' – even the moments that we wish didn't happen – is to acknowledge that God is ultimately in charge and always working away for our good. As St Paul once wrote, "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose." (Romans 8:28)

One of the great gifts of priesthood for me is the diversity and variety of experiences that have come my way. I enjoy parish life, and walking together with a community of faith. I am also involved with the formation of those studying for ordination at Holy Spirit Seminary, Banyo, and enjoy the opportunity to shape the future priests of Queensland. In addition, I work with Brisbane Catholic Education which has such an important and pivotal role in the mission of the church here in our local diocese. These roles offer me the chance to learn, to stretch myself, to work with many people in a variety of situations, and to offer in service whatever gifts I might have. All this ensures that I am never bored!

So anniversaries of ordination are an opportunity to be grateful, and to stand before God in humility, and ask for God's continued care and mercy in life. And I am also grateful to this community for your welcome to me in these early weeks. May we all walk together to the future that God has in store for us, taking one small step at time. Markers along the way, like anniversaries, help us realise how far we have come – thanks be to God!

A NEW CHAPTER FOR ST AGATHA'S WELCOME TO FATHER ANTHONY MELLOR



As one chapter here at St Agatha's closed at the end of October, a new one has started with the arrival of our new Parish Priest - Father Anthony Mellor. Father Anthony was ordained in 1997 and is no stranger to parish life and no stranger to Brisbane and Queensland. He has served in many parishes within the Archdioceses from Ipswich, his first appointment, then as parish priest in Gayndah and Maryborough. In 2005 he was appointed Administrator in 6 parishes, Ashgrove, Bardon, Herston, Newmarket and

Rosalie (which was later to become the Jubilee Parish). With north of the river pretty much covered, Father Anthony was sent to Rome (Italy) in late 2006 to study theology, and he is now nearing the completion of his Doctorate in Theology. Returning from Rome, Father Anthony has served as an Administrator in the parishes of Birkdale, Hendra and the Gap, and most recently at Victoria Point. In addition to Parish life, and studying, Father Anthony has worked in Adult Education. He is also appointed one day a week as Academic Dean of Holy Spirit Seminary and two days a week as Theological Advisor to Brisbane Catholic Education. From this brief summary it is clear that Father Anthony has the skills and leadership to take us through this new Chapter and many more. Father Anthony please accept our very warm welcome to the Parish of St Agatha's and we look forward to your leadership in this new Chapter.
