Dear friends,

It is good to be back with you after my break. Thank you to Fr. Prem, Fr. Orm, Rosemary, Jane and Peter for keeping the parish on track while I was away. Our big celebration is now only a week away. Please remember that next Sunday is our Centenary Mass with Archbishop Mark Coleridge. There will be only one Sunday Mass at 10am next week. However, there will also be our usual Saturday evening Mass at 5pm. I hope that you can join us for this special celebration and stay on afterwards for what promises to be a great morning of community hospitality and joyful reminiscing. Please invite any former parishioners with whom you may still be in contact to be part of next Sunday's celebration. Our school choir will be singing before Mass at 9:30am. A "street party' on Oriel Rd will follow which means that Oriel Rd, directly out the front of the church, will be closed for the morning. There will be a "drop-off" area from Waratah St to Hunter Lane for those who need access closer to the church. There will be (very) minimal parking in our disability-access car parks. Please call the parish office if you need further information. I look forward to sharing the day with you.

To a more immediate matter at hand: this weekend we welcome those children who are enrolling for the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. They will be confirmed by Archbishop Coleridge in early September. We pray that they and their families will be especially blessed by the fruits of the Holy Spirit during this preparation time. I am sure that you will make our families feel welcome this weekend. In the cycle of readings, we are in Year B which, for the most part, follows Mark's gospel — except for these few weeks. Because Mark's gospel is the shortest of the gospels, the gospel readings for the Sundays of the liturgical year are filled out with some readings from John's gospel. We have in these weeks, a prolonged meditation on "the bread of life" passages from John's gospel. Over the next weeks, the Sunday gospels will sound more or less the same. However, each is subtly different, reflecting, like the facets of a diamond, different aspects of the Eucharistic mystery. You might consider what the Eucharist means to you and how Jesus has feed your hungers though the Eucharist over the course of a lifetime. It is this gift of the Eucharist which has sustained St. Agatha's community for almost 100 years and for this we give thanks today, next Sunday and every Sunday. Fr. Anthony
