St Agatha's Church celebrate, pray and worship together... (Covid 19 Safe Plan)

During this time of re-opening the churches let us thank and praise our Lord.

Our Parish is using the approved Industry Covid-Safe plan when we open the Church beyond existing number restrictions. From next weekend 11/12 July, Mass attendance numbers will increase and we will be returning to our normal **four** Masses, Saturday (Vigil) 5pm, Sunday 7am, 9am and 5.30pm. Due to the complexities and restrictions in place, a booking system has been set up.

Please note that the online bookings will close on Friday at 10.00am, prior to each weekend.

It is **important** that you book for any weekend Masses that you wish to attend. If you would like any help with the online booking or do not have access to email, please contact the Parish Office.

If you are booking for other members of your family (different residential address) or friends you must book individual tickets for them, not all under your name and address.

As of Monday 13 July, no bookings necessary for weekday Masses, just sign-in when you arrive. If you have not previously given your contact details in at the Parish office please give your contact details when you arrive.

Please take note that singing is only restricted to a Cantor without congregational participation.

CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS FOR MASS RE- OPENING

Your assistance is needed for our parish to worship in larger numbers. We all need to pull together to get St Agatha's parish Church back up and running.

The proposed celebration of our regular Holy Masses on the 11th/12th July is dependent on whether or not we have sufficient volunteers in the necessary roles of Monitor and Cleaners. We can only have our regular Masses with the required monitors and cleaners identified, trained and rostered. .../2

MASS MONITORS (Marshals) ARE REQUIRED

Please let the parish office know if you can be rostered for the key role of Monitor at one or more of our proposed Masses. This is an area of most need for us to re-open.

The help of Mass monitors

We need the help of monitors for both weekends and weekdays who are below the age of 70. On weekends we need 2-3 monitors.

- * Help the people to sign in the register at the entrance.
- * Assisting people to use the hand sanitizer.
- * Monitoring and providing advice to attendees on maintaining social distancing
- * Arrive 1/2 hour before mass.

<u>CLEANERS</u> – (Can be any age in reasonable health) Ideally in teams of 3 but a minimum of 2 per Mass, to wipe down all surfaces commonly touched (pews, door handles, railings, toilets, etc.) immediately after each Mass is over. Please note that all appropriate personal protective equipment will be provided by the parish along with role training. Non-toxic and non-hazardous cleaning liquids will be used in the cleaning process.

LEADER:

- * Monitoring the readers and those who take the offertory.
- * Welcoming the community before Mass (reading the introduction to Mass).
- * Read Parish news, readings.
- * Distribute newsletter, if below the age of 70.

Please contact the Parish Office on 3262 2859 if you can commit to one or both of the above roles and indicate the Mass times in our new schedule that you can be available for.

Also, a friendly reminder for the safety of others that if you are feeling unwell, have a temperature, or show any flu like symptoms, please do not attend the church, because, we have the same responsibility to care for others as we look after ourselves. Stay safe and stay tuned for any updates as the situation changes.
