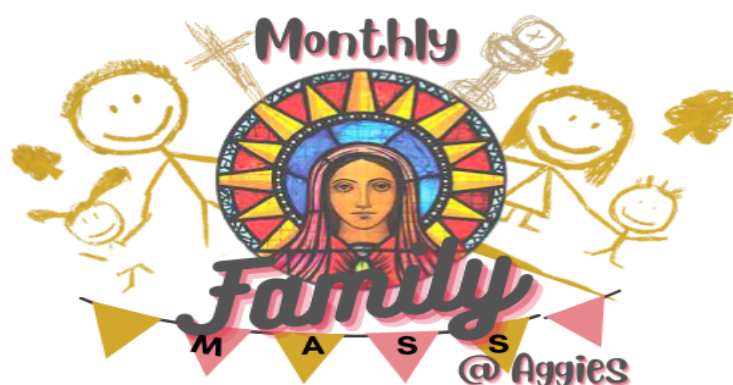

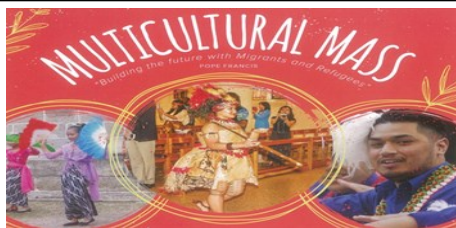
FUTURE OF THE PARISH
