The Prayer Engine are also making their way to Nudgee Cemetery at 11:30am



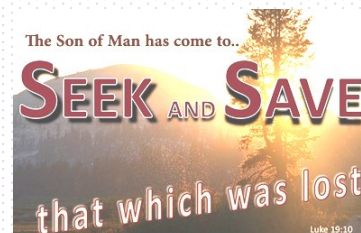
Finally Congratulations to Mr and Mrs Smith formerly Colin Smith and Mail Trill on their lovely wedding at OLHC last Saturday.

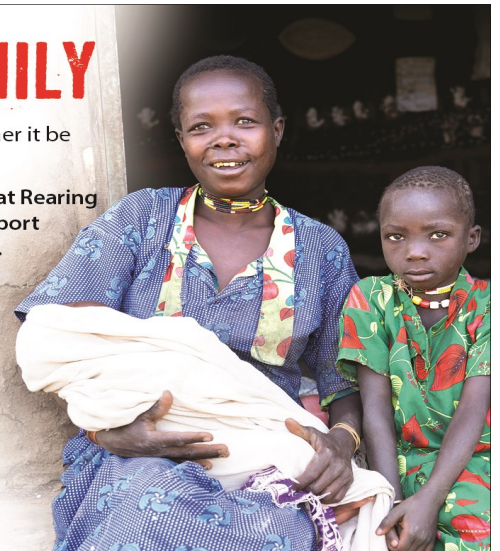

 we are brothers and sisters.

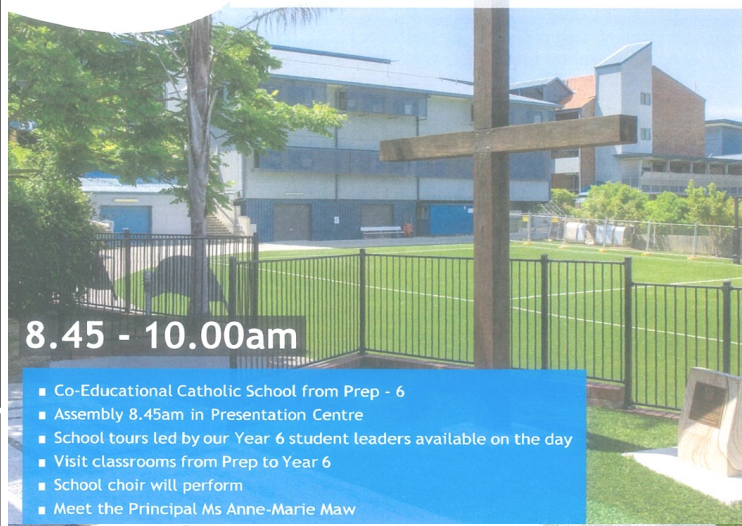
