In forming our council, we will bring together a team of people to help me in leading the parish. The role of the council is to:

- plan for the future of our parish
- identify new ways in which we can become more mission-oriented
- contribute to building a thriving community life across the parish
- * support our various ministry volunteers

We've now opened nominations for the council and would like to invite all parishioners to consider who they might put forward as someone who you see as a leader in our community. There is no limit on how many people an individual can nominate and parishioners are welcome to nominate themselves should they wish. When you nominate someone, you will be asked their name and the strengths you see they would bring to the council.

Nominations will close on Sunday 19th February. Following this, all nominated parishioners will be contacted and invited to attend an information session on Tuesday 28th February about the role of being on the council before they indicate whether they are willing to accept their nomination. Following the information session, depending on the number of parishioners who accept nomination further steps will be initiated to decide the council.

St Agatha - Our Parish Heavenly Patroness

St. Agatha is a virgin-martyr of the early Church. From her very early years, the notably beautiful Agatha dedicated her life to God. She became a consecrated virgin, a state in life

where young women choose to remain celibate and give themselves wholly to Jesus and the Church in a life of prayer and service.

She endured horrific suffering during her life and made many sacrifices for her faith. For all her suffering she is known as the patron saint of Sicily, bell founders, breast cancer patients, Palermo, rape victims and wet nurses. She is also considered to be a powerful intercessor when people suffer from fires.
