

- * identify new ways in which we can become more **mission-oriented**
- * contribute to building a thriving community life across the parish
- * support our various ministry volunteers

We've now opened nominations for the council and would like to invite all parishioners to consider who they might put forward as someone who you see as a leader in our community. There is no limit on how many people an individual can nominate and parishioners are welcome to nominate themselves should they wish. When you nominate someone, you will be asked their name and the strengths you see they would bring to the council.

Nominations will close this **Sunday 19th February**. Following this, all nominated parishioners will be contacted and invited to attend an information session on **Tuesday 28th February** about the role of being on the council before they indicate whether they are willing to accept their nomination. Following the information session, depending on the number of parishioners who accept nomination further steps will be initiated to decide the council.



Aboriginal Catholic Mass

Do you remember, or if you don't, did you know of the historic celebration of a special Aboriginal Mass at the Eucharistic Congress in Melbourne in 1973? Friday, 24th February, 2023, marks the 50th anniversary of this remarkable event which was attended by some 30,000 people. Aboriginal singers and dancers from north and west of Australia took an active part in the original liturgy which broke new ground in the Church's liturgical renewal.

To commemorate this occasion. Mass will be celebrated in the Cathedral of St Stephen on Thursday, 23rd February, 2023, commencing 12.30pm. The Archbishop has granted special approval to use the revised liturgical texts from that original celebration. Please join us for this occasion.
