Introducing Archbishop Mark's Apostolic Priorities.

In recent weeks, Archbishop Mark has published a document entitled "Lamps Ablaze: Apostolic Priorities for the Archdiocese of Brisbane from 2023" which outlines seven priorities for us all to consider. Over seven weeks, concluding with Pentecost, clergy around the Archdiocese have been encouraged to preach on these apostolic priorities with reference to the readings for each Sunday. This week's is Bringing Cultural Communities to the Centre.

Lamps Ablaze: Apostolic Priorities for the Archdiocese of Brisbane

Priority Three: Bringing Cultural Communities to the Centre

"The face of the Church around the world is changing as the centre of gravity shifts from places like Europe and North America (and Australia) to Africa, Asia and Latin America...

Certainly in the Archdiocese the presence of people who have come from overseas – from Vietnam, the Philippines, the Pacific islands, India, Sri Lanka, Latin America, Africa – is growing stronger...

These large and growing communities have gifts for the whole Church, and increasingly the centre of gravity in the Church here is moving in their direction. Therefore, they have to be brought more to centre-stage in the life and mission of the Archdiocese, since much of the real spiritual energy in the Church here is found among them.

This again will involve significant cultural change for the whole Church in this part

What is an Oblate

The word 'oblate' means 'gift or 'offering'.

Oblates offer their lives to God in a specific and intentional way, promising to live according to the 'Rule of St Benedict', as far as their personal state of life allows.

An oblate can be a woman or man, married or single (or religious clergy), of any Christian denomination.

Oblates commit to a specific Benedictine Community (mine being Jamberoo Abbey, south of Sydney), and enjoy the benefits that come from being part of that spiritual family.

While going about our everyday lives, with normal work and family responsibilities, our daily lifestyle is centred around our sacred, silent time with the Lord - in Lectio Divina (meditating on the Sacred Scriptures), the Divine Office and Holy Mass.




