Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 9 July 2023 (Year A)

Hi all,

The 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A, focuses on the theme of discipleship and the challenges that come with following Jesus. The readings for this Sunday highlight the call to discipleship and the necessary qualities of a true disciple.

The first reading is from the Book of Zechariah (9:9-10), in which the prophet speaks of the coming of a king who is just and humble, riding on a donkey. This passage

is seen as a messianic prophecy, pointing to Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. It emphasizes the humble nature of Jesus' mission and the qualities of meekness and righteousness that should characterize his followers.

The responsorial psalm (Psalm 145:1-2, 8-11, 13-14) praises God's goodness and faithfulness. It echoes the themes of humility and trust in God's providence, recognizing God as the source of all blessings and the one who lifts up the lowly.

In the second reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans (8:9, 11-13), Paul emphasizes the importance of the Holy Spirit in the life of a believer. He reminds the Christians in Rome that they have received the Spirit of Christ, which empowers them to live according to the Spirit and put to death the deeds of the flesh. Paul encourages them to embrace their new life in Christ, renouncing sin and living in righteousness.

The Gospel reading (Matthew 11:25-30) presents Jesus' invitation to discipleship. He praises the Father for revealing the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven to the childlike and humble, while they remain hidden from the wise and learned. Jesus invites all who are burdened and weary to come to him for rest, promising to give them rest for their souls. He offers a yoke that is easy and a burden that is light, contrasting it with the heavy burdens imposed by the religious leaders of the time. Jesus presents himself as the model of humility and meekness, and calls upon his followers to take up his yoke and learn from him.

Overall, the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A, emphasizes the qualities of humility, meekness, and trust in God's providence that should characterize the life of a disciple. It invites believers to embrace the teachings of Jesus, find rest in him, and follow his example in serving others. [Chat GPT]

Bishop Ken's installation as the seventh Bishop of Toowoomba will be held on Tuesday 11 July 2023 at the Cathedral of St Patrick.




