who are interested in volunteering their time with facilitating the **FOCCUS Pre-marriage Course** (Facilitate Open, Couple Communication, Understanding and Study). This course is run by Centacare in the Archdiocese of Brisbane for engaged couples. If you become a trained facilitator, you can lead the couples in conjunction with myself. I find facilitating these discussions is personally rewarding and it's a wonderful way to pass on your wisdom to couples. It's another vital area in our Parish Community. Strong and well-formed marriages lead to resilient and evangelical families.







In this week's Gospel, Jesus uses vivid images to describe the Kingdom of Heaven. He compares it to a hidden treasure that a man finds in a field and a valuable pearl that a merchant seeks and sells everything to obtain. Jesus also tells the parable of the fishing net that catches fish of all kinds, representing the gathering of people from all nations into the Kingdom. These parables emphasize the incomparable worth of the Kingdom of Heaven and the need to prioritize it above all worldly possessions. They call for a wholehearted commitment to seek and embrace the Kingdom's values in one's life.

Overall, the readings for the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time offer messages of seeking God's wisdom and guidance, trusting in His providence, and recognizing the supreme value of the Kingdom of Heaven. They encourage believers to centre their lives on God's will and find joy in following His ways.
