- 1. **Preparation and Waiting:** The readings for the Second Sunday of Advent often emphasize the importance of preparation and waiting. 
As you reflect on these themes, may your Advent season be a time of spiritual growth, deepening relationships, and a renewed sense of hope and anticipation for the coming of Christ.


