First Sunday of Lent 18 February 2024 (YEAR B)

At the heart of the human person is an insatiable appetite. In one sense this is a positive, as it points to who we are fundamentally. We desire the infinite because we are made for eternal life. Often, however, we seek solace and consolation in the material things of the world, and in the relationships we form with those whom we cherish. This is necessary; but these things, good as they are, cannot fill the infinite void within our souls.



Herein lies the danger. We pursue more and more of the good things of this world and yet are not satisfied. If our remedy is to pursue even more, we find ourselves struggling with an addictive impulse. We are made for more, but that more is God.

During this season of Lent we undertake a time of penance. We respond to our spiritual appetite by fasting and prayer. Not that we might hunger less, but rather, that we might gain insight as to who alone can satisfy.

A memorable passage from St Augustine, in his "Confessions", sums up this reality with his unparalleled elegance:

Late have I loved you, beauty so old and so new: late have I loved you. And see, you were within and I was in the external world and sought you there, and in my unlovely state I plunged into those lovely created things which you made. You were with me, and I was not with you....You called and cried out loud and shattered my deafness. You were radiant and resplendent, you put to flight my blindness. You were fragrant, and I drew in my breath and now pant after you. I tasted you, and I feel but hunger and thirst for you. You touched me, and I am set on fire to attain the peace which is yours."



First Sunday of Lent This year our Lenten journey begins with Mark's Gospel. In this passage, Jesus comes from Nazareth and is baptized by John. Prior to this time, Jesus had been living a rather normal and obscure life. As he came out of the water, he heard a voice that said, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased." Jesus was being prepared by the Holy Spirit for his ministry to the people of Israel and to all people. At once, the Spirit sent Jesus into the wilderness. During those 40 days, Jesus had time to reflect upon and prepare for his future ministry. He was also tempted by Satan. His reflection gave him the strength to say "no" to that which was not of God. After John was put in prison, Jesus had the courage to begin to share the "Good News" in

In our own lives, we share in the same baptism. We are called by name and given a mission. Our baptismal commitment also prepares us for the challenges of life. We can be tempted to give up, distrust our own mission, or be discouraged by the lack of positive results. When we go through difficult times, our faith tells us that God will give us the graces that we need. With that assurance, we too can share the Good News with others.

We need to make many decisions in our lives, some big decisions and many smaller ones on a daily basis. Lent is a good time to reflect on those decisions and the path that we are on. "Make me to know your ways, O Lord; teach me your paths" (Psalm 25:4)... Sister Yvonne Hatt, CSC
