Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time 11 February 2024 (YEAR B)

"Whatever you eat, whatever you drink, whatever you do at all, do it for the glory of God". These words, from St Paul's letter to the church in Corinth, are the key to an authentically catholic spirituality. The word catholic means 'universal' - in the sense of all inclusive.

There is a temptation, always present, to confine prayer and religious practice to certain narrow and well-defined places in our lives. We go to church on Sundays and say some prayers during day. That is well and good, these formal moments of prayer are necessary. Our faith, however, is not narrow and confined but permeates every aspect of our lives.



In many ways, this passage reminds me of the writings of St. Therese of Lisieux and her so called 'little way'. St Therese recognised that she didn't have within herself the possibility of doing great acts of love and devotion for God. She could not be like the cedars in the forest (great men and women of heroic faith). Nevertheless, she could offer her love and devotion to God in and through all the little things she did each day. She offered all the little things of her life for God's glory. It was this path of 'little virtues', each one lovingly offered to God, which defined her spirituality. She could not be a great tree in God's garden, but she could be a little flower.

Life consists of many little task, undertaken each day: working, cleaning, preparing children for school and so on. These can become a burden to us. Yet by raising our hearts to God and offering each of these tasks for His glory, they can become an integral part of our catholic spirituality. We still feel the burden of the tasks, but these can be joyful burdens, each one an act of love and an offering of praise to God.


> In 2025 the Catholic Churches are hosts of World Day of Prayer - the Cook Islands.
