The Most Holy Trinity 26 May 2024 (YEAR B)

This weekend we celebrate Trinity Sunday. In other words, we focus our attention on the Mystery of who God is in God's very being. We proclaim God, 'Father, Son and Holy Spirit', not three God's, but rather, three persons in One God.


When we use the word 'mystery' to refer to God, we do not mean it in the lesser sense; e.g. a mystery we might solve if only we had a few more clues and Hercule Poirot on the case. Rather, we mean it



in the greater sense of 'something beyond our comprehension'. Thus, when we approach the mystery of who God is, we must do so with total humility. God is to be contemplated, but not grasped.

The good news for us is that we don't need to fully grasp the nature of the Trinity. The essence of our faith does not lie in solving the riddle of who God is nor coming to a secret knowledge (as was typical of Gnostic thought). God has revealed Himself in the person of Jesus, whom we can come to know. Jesus says of himself: "to have seen me is to have seen the Father" (Jn 14:9). Furthermore, he sends out the Spirit to dwell within the souls of the faithful, making us sharers in the very life of the Trinity.

Can we understand all this? The answer is a resounding no. However, we can raise our hearts and minds to God, awe-filled by the august Mystery we contemplate. In the intimacy of prayer, we can come to 'know' the presence of our loving God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

It is through the grace of God he continues his ministry in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia.



The Queensland Government have released a draft Anti-Discrimination bill, that would be the most restrictive regime in Australia for religious freedoms. It would significantly restrict the ability of churches, schools and other faith organisations to choose who we employ, as well as introducing other harsh restrictions. *Please see attached the letter to the Premier from the signatory faith organisations of Queensland*.
