# Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 30 June 2024 (YEAR B)

This weekend, I would like to say a great big 'thank you' for your generosity in supporting all the various causes for which we take up collections. I know it seems like there is an endless number of charitable causes seeking our support, and we can't necessarily support each one, but it is, as this weekend's second reading says, a matter of balancing our surplus with someone else's need. We give as we can, and you give generously!



In his second letter to the Corinthians, St Paul reminds the church of Christ's generosity. He, though rich in the presence of the Father, gave of himself and entered into the poverty of our human condition. He did so, not for his own benefit, but rather so that we might share in his bounty. Charity, therefore, is not simply at the periphery of our faith but rather constitutes the very heart. We are called to participate in the charity of Christ by making our lives an offering alongside his.

It is true that some have a larger financial surplus than others. This should not inhibit charity. We can remember the 'widow's mite', a small offering in monetary value yet abundant in charity! Even those with limited material resources can exercise charity by praying for the various causes that seek our support.

This weekend, we will take up the Peter's Pence collection. It will be taken up as a retiring collection. These funds, collected around the world, go to support the charitable works of the Holy See and ultimately, many of the most vulnerable people in our world. Please give as generously as you are able.




