Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 7 July 2024 (YEAR B)

In our world, with all its change and flux, questions of meaning and identity are paramount. How do we ground ourselves in something solid, so we are not swayed by every new trend? In the constant contest for truth and a prevailing social narrative, where do we find stability and direction?

Each of us holds on to the past to some extent. Traditions, memories, and relationships offer familiarity and groundedness. However, clinging too tightly can make us rigid and unable to adapt to necessary changes. This often leads us to merely survive rather than thrive.

On the other hand, some focus primarily on progress. Can we build a better world for future generations? But progress towards what? Without understanding where we've come from and formulating a common vision, we cannot agree on what 'progress' means, leading to chaos.

Neither tradition nor progress alone is sufficient. We must find identity and meaning in the complex interplay of both. This is especially true for our two parishes. We cannot afford to be unchanging, nor can we undervalue the stability which our connection with the church provides.

Let us pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance as we embrace change. May we hold on to what is truly important, founding our identity on the Rock of Christ, who sends His church on mission!

On a practical note, we will soon be implementing a small but significant change. We will move to a combined newsletter. This approach will reduce the inefficiencies of producing two nearly identical newsletters each week and minimise the potential for miscommunication. Most importantly, it will enhance our identity as a 'community of communities,' striving to implement Christ's mission. When the change is implemented, I would welcome any feedback on improving our newsletter.

Reflection by Dianne Bergant CSA

It is not easy to recognise a true prophet. Frequently those with prophetic insight are treated without honour. The people to whom Ezekiel was sent were hard of face, obstinate of heart, a rebellious house. The Galileans who heard Jesus' words were no better. They questioned his authenticity because they thought he was no better than they were and, therefore, he had no right to act superior. We so often resent people who can do what we cannot. This resentment can be magnified when the person is someone with whom we have grown up, a member of the family or of the community.

True believers recognise and admit their human frailty. They also know that genuine weakness does not impede the saving action of God. In fact, God seems to *prefer* to act where pride and self-satisfaction do not prevail, for such attitudes are obstacles to personal transformation. However, when we open ourselves in humility and honest piety, the power of God can flood our minds and our hearts and shine forth from us to all around. When this happens, there will be no doubt in any mind as to the origin of this wondrous reality. It will be very clear that though it comes *through* us, it comes *from* God. The receptivity of Paul in this matter is in sharp contrast to the rebellion of the people at the time of Ezekiel and the resistance of those who thought that they knew Jesus so well. We acknowledge the Turrbal and Jagera people, the traditional custodians of the Land on which St Agatha's is built. We pay our respects to Elders past, present and emerging.
