Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 28 July 2024 (YEAR B)

We have grown accustomed to referring to those who have a particular call within the Church as having a vocation (e.g., priest, religious, or perhaps a lay missionary). Indeed, they do - God has called them to that work. The word vocation comes from the Latin word *vocare*, meaning 'to call'. Yet, when St Paul writes, encouraging his readers to "live a life worthy of your vocation," he is not writing to a



select few but rather to the whole Church. To be in the Church is to have a vocation because it is God who has called us to belong.

It's worth pondering: 'Do I have a palpable sense of vocation?' God has called you to belong to his Church, with a purpose. He has called you firstly as a token of his love for you. God wills your salvation and your holiness. This call to holiness of life is the primary vocation of every person, and this is what St Paul refers to in his letter to the Ephesians.

Yet, we are not called just for ourselves. A sense of piety that is focused only on one's own needs is hardly holiness. Christ poured himself out for others, and so any genuine call to holiness within the Christian context is necessarily lived for the other.

Let us pray for the Spirit of Holiness, the Paraclete, to fall upon us and ignite within us a renewal of God's calling. As an act of sheer grace, he has called us to this place and to this moment. This should fill us with joy, but also a sense of purpose. Let us ask the Spirit to guide us as we ponder the question: 'How do we live lives which are worthy of our vocation?'
