Gospel Reflection (Charles Nguyen—seminarian)

As we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent, we are met with an interesting reading that presents a heartfelt teaching from Saint Paul the Apostle. As I reflected on the prayer of thanksgiving from Saint Paul to the Thessalonian community, I understood that we are also invited to pray the same prayer for



one another. Lord Jesus has come into our world for the first time in Bethlehem, and He promised that He would come again. In Greek, this is called Parousia, meaning 'The coming of the Lord'.

For each of us, the coming of the Lord—the End Time—is the moment of death. Father Michael said, in one of his homilies, that there are two attitudes when approaching the Lord: joyfulness and fear. The Lord is unchanging in His love for us; it is we who constantly change our choices, whether by removing ourselves from such love because of sin, or by embracing love through leaning on the Lord for strength and faith against temptations.

Just like the Thessalonian community, who at the time were waiting for the imminent second coming of Lord Jesus Christ, we too must prepare ourselves earnestly so as "to be blameless in holiness" as we await Lord Jesus in exultation and hopefulness, not in fear or worry. Advent is the time of waiting for the coming of the Lord, and we wait, according to Saint Paul, by loving one another and loving more than we already have.

Lord Jesus has said: "Whoever listens to you listens to me" (Lk 10:16) and "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word" (Jn 14:23). As Saint Paul reminds the community of the instructions and teachings they have been given, we too are reminded that we have been given the same instructions, teachings, and expectations. We must strive to uphold them, even in our weaknesses.

Thus, we must hold one another accountable—not in a condemning manner, but lovingly and encouragingly as neighbours and as a community. Let us challenge each other to live as children of the Father in this season of Advent, so that we may better prepare ourselves to welcome the coming of Christ, both at Christmas and when He comes again in glory.


