Gospel Reflection (Charles Nguyen—seminarian)

The second reading of today's Solemnity of Christ the King (Revelation 1, 5-8) helps me understand the kind of King Jesus is, especially in verse 5: "He loves us and has washed away our sins with



His Blood, and made us a line of kings, priests to serve His God and Father." Hence, I would like to share some of my thoughts and reflections on this reading.

I have never known or read of any kings as great as King Jesus: all the kings in history have only governed and ruled the people of their kingdoms. As for King Jesus, He does not only govern but also love. His way of loving is also unique: He loves us by cleansing us from our sins, not by water, but by His own Blood poured out for us on the Cross. Truly, no kings in the history of humanity have used their blood to wash away the sins of their people.

Moreover, because we are washed clean from sins by King Jesus' Blood, we are made priests, meaning to be made worthy to stand at the Altar and offer the Sacrifice to the Lord.

What is written in the Book of Revelation is also clearly portrayed in the Mass: The Mass is the re-enactment of Jesus' Death on the Cross to pour out His Blood for the washing of our sins. In the Mass, the baptised exercise a priesthood too, the Sacrifice of our lives which we offer up to God the Father alongside Jesus' own sacrifice. Thus, whenever we celebrate the Mass, we are proclaiming Jesus Christ as a Loving King and we are also exercising our priesthood, the priesthood of the baptised, which has been gifted to us by King Jesus.



<u>So, to you</u> Christians l repeat His name, to everyone, l proclaim Him, Jesus Christ is the beginning and the end, the Alpha and the Omega. He is the king of the new world. He is the secret of history. He is the key to our destiny.






