Gospel Reflection (Charles Nguyen—seminarian)

Today is already the 3rd Sunday of Advent, and the reading from Saint Paul's letter shows us how we can live in the joy of the Lord (verse 4): living with a generous and gentle heart (verse 5), without worries by leaning on the Lord (verse 6), and with a mind always in communion



leaning on the Lord (verse 6), and with a mind always in communion with Lord Jesus Christ (verse 7). This joy is not just a fleeting emotion but comes from within. It is present even during times of suffering and pain because it flourishes and blossoms from the way we live our lives and from our attitude toward our neighbors and God—treating others with kindness and generosity, praying to God in all circumstances without worries, and living peacefully by relying on God and His plans for us. This is the joy Saint Paul refers to, and it is not because we feel like doing good things, but because we choose to do them, even when it puts us at a disadvantage or brings us no benefit. We then give thanks to God for all that He has given us, not because God needs our thanks, but because we are invited to live with humility and a close connection with God.

Through thanksgiving, our prayer and our thinking slowly align with God's will for us. In this way, our thanksgiving benefits us because we, again, 'choose' to follow the will of the Lord, even when we don't fully understand or when we seem to experience difficulties. Let's pray for each other, as Saint Paul prayed for his community, and live according to his teachings so that we would rejoice and live in the peace of the Lord through prayer and thanksgiving. Let's also encourage one another to always choose to follow the will of the Lord, even during times of trials and hardships, as we wait for the Lord in the upcoming Christmas season.


