We live in a world where a sense of community - and, even more so, a sense of actively participating in and contributing to the life of that community - cannot be taken for granted. This reflects the pressures of modern life but also a more individualistic way of understanding and living our lives.

In today's second reading, St Paul reminds us of the essential nature of belonging to the community:

"If the foot were to say, 'I am not a hand, and so I do not belong to the body,' would that mean it is not a part of the body...?"

By our very nature, we are wired for community and participation in community life. When we withdraw from that, we simply do not thrive.

I would like to encourage each one of you to be an active part of our parish community and to contribute - either formally or informally. Each of us can do something, however small, and that something is vital to the health of the whole body. Indeed, if each person did their one thing, that would be more than enough!

In my life, I have found the following to be true: however much I might give, I receive more than I can give. The more I have given, the more I have received.




