

meant to be filled with the light of Christ. The special grace of this season is to look upon our Saviour as he walks the path to Calvary and so witness God's great work of re-creation. Yes, our heads and our hearts are bowed in reverence of the mystery and in honour of the sufferings

of Christ, but we are not despondent. On the contrary, this Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent, is known as Laetare Sunday; Laetare means 'rejoice'.

In his Second Letter to the Church in Corinth, St Paul articulates the special kind of Lenten joy. It is not yet the full burst of exultant praise reserved for the Easter celebrations; nonetheless, we rejoice as we contemplate the meaning of the death of Christ. For indeed, through Christ, we too are beckoned: "Be reconciled to God." It is out of supreme love for us that the Father sent his only Son, so that we might have the fullness of life. Thus, even as we walk with Christ along the Via Dolorosa, we begin to anticipate the fullness of the Resurrection, allowing a guiet yet confident joy to grow within us.

This, then, is the season of mercy, the time of reconciling grace. It is a wonderful time to make use of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. To help facilitate this, I will be available in the church during the following times:
