We come now to the week that sits at the heart of our faith, "Holy Week", the celebration of the passion of Christ, his suffering, death, and ultimately his resurrection. We commence with Palm Sunday, where his triumphal entrance into the holy city of Jerusalem is commemorated, before reading the passion, the account of his death. How quickly the crowd turns, first they call out "Hosanna" to their coming king, but next "crucify him".

If Holy Week is the heart of our faith, then the heart of Holy Week is the Triduum - the 'three days' of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Saturday (the Easter Vigil). These are the premier celebrations of the year, to be celebrated with as much solemnity and dignity as we can muster.

Dear brothers and sisters, my invitation to you is this: do not let Holy Week be just another week. Rather, let it be truly holy, marked by family prayer, reflections on the story of Christ's sacrifice, and especially by our participation in the liturgies of the week. In this sacred celebration, Christ draws near to us and bids us lift up our hearts.

Let them not remain unmoved.
