As we draw near to the great feast of our salvation, it is good to remember by what means we are saved. In this time of Lent, when we practise the disciplines of prayer, fasting, and charitable giving, we can be tempted to think that it is these 'good works' which are the source of our salvation. This is, of course, not the case. Can any sacrifice of mine, however great, reconcile me with God? No!

The source of our salvation is Christ himself. He is the one who makes the sacrificial offering, once and for all. This reality sits at the heart of St Paul's letter to the Philippians, from which we read in this weekend's second reading. It is by belonging to Christ, and by uniting our offering with him, that we are reconciled. This is the "supreme advantage" that St Paul speaks about.

What, then, of our Lenten discipline? Should I give up striving for perfection? Salvation is a gift, and the healing which God brings about in our souls is the action of grace. Yet, we must co-operate with grace. God does not impose upon us but rather calls for our participation.

When we fast, let's not do so in order to demonstrate our own perfection. Rather, we grow in hunger for the more lasting satisfaction of knowing the Lord. Likewise, as we pray, it is not some feat of mental gymnastics that makes our prayer acceptable to God. God loves the humble prayers of a little child as much as the more 'perfect' prayer of the spiritually advanced. Finally, when we give, is it not but an overflow of the charity we have received? For Christ has paid our ransom and given his all that we might have life!

Let's offer a special prayer for the St Agatha's community as they celebrate the 100th anniversary of the dedication of the church! For those on holiday, stay safe and have a great time.


