Dear Parents,

I am happy to inform you that the parishes of St Agatha's, Clayfield and Mother of Mercy, Northgate, Hendra and Hamilton are currently accepting candidates to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. Our parishes operate a combined sacramental program across both communities.

Your child is eligible for this Sacrament if she or he is in Year 3 or above and has already received the Sacrament of Baptism.

Confirmation is the sacrament of initiation that seals a person's decision to be a follower of Christ. This Sacrament reflects the story of Pentecost when Jesus' disciples were anointed with the Holy Spirit with tongues of fire. Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation requires a commitment to attend all of the preparation sessions outlined in the attached Preparation Schedule. Please peruse these dates carefully. The first preparation session shall be held in June and Confirmations shall be early August. These sessions shall be facilitated by Pastoral Associate, Sandy Cantarutti and me.

I pray you are able to prioritise these sessions. If so, please complete this electronic enrolment form and don't forget to register for the first session. If you feel you are unable to fully commit to this program, please consider deferring your enrolment to another year. Enrolments close on Sunday 15th June.

As part of the preparation, children will be given a Mass Passport to mark their attendance at 4 masses. There are currently passports available to collect in all churches if you are keen to start coming to Mass.

Importantly, please mark the feast of Pentecost in your diaries: Sunday June 8th. You are all invited to celebrate Pentecost Sunday to kick-start your child's Sacramental journey. Volunteers at our morning Masses have organised a Pentecost Party with red cakes and flame party hats.

Event Information

- The role of the sponsor is to accompany the child during the anointing (right hand on right shoulder as pictured below). The sponsor acts as a Christian role model for the child throughout his/her life. The sponsor needs to be a baptised Catholic, (16+) and cannot be the child's own parent.
- The sponsor will hand to the bishop/priest the name card with the child's name (or optional saint's name).
- Attire is 'dressy'. No particular colour is required for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Wearing a touch a red is nice... but not necessary!
- Family photography is available 1 hour before.
- A photo shall also be taken during your child's anointing (see picture below).
- A link to purchase the photos shall be mailed to you approximately one month later.
- Please consider if your child would like to do a job or reading at Confirmation (drawn from hat).
- Street parking only at both St Agatha's Church and Our Lady Help of Christians. Please arrive early in order to find a carpark, receive your gift, collect child's name card and to line up for family photos).
- Seating: Your family will have access to <u>one</u> pew. Pews will **not** be reserved by name (unless you are a reader), so please follow the 'first-in-first served' approach with seating.
- Pews fit approximately 6 people (including your child sitting in the aisle seat and the sponsor beside the child).
- If any other family members do not fit in your <u>one</u> pew, they may be seated in some spare rows at the back of the church.
- Children shall receive a cupcake at the end of Confirmation. Please specify dietary requirements when required (dietary requirement boxes shall be labelled with the child's name).
- We are not certain whether a Bishop will be available to celebrate this liturgy. You will be informed of this closer to the date. Fr Michael will be available also.
