This weekend's Feast of the Ascension recalls how Jesus, after his Resurrection and the completion of his earthly mission, ascended into heaven—still clothed in our shared humanity. This feast offers us a potent sign of our own destiny: those who place their trust in Christ and follow where the Master has led will surely arrive at the same destination.



I sometimes ponder the significance of the visual / physical sign Jesus gave to his Apostles—by ascending into the clouds. It seems to me this action serves two key purposes. Firstly, rather than simply vanishing without a trace, Jesus chooses this moment as a clear and definitive end to his time on earth. Secondly, the events surrounding the Ascension serve to teach us about the nature of the Church.

After the Ascension, the Apostles linger, gazing upward into the sky. This signifies the Church at prayer—with her eyes fixed on Christ and her heart contemplating where he has gone. The Apostles, however, are soon interrupted by angelic messengers who reprimand them for standing there, staring into the sky. This is a gentle reminder that the Church has a mission to carry out, the mission entrusted to her by Christ himself. Yet, even in this moment of redirection, the angels speak a word of hope: "Jesus will return in the same way you saw him go there."

As Christians, we are called to live between heaven and earth. We are to raise our eyes to the skies, contemplating the glory of Christ and thus allow our hope to deepen. But we must also remain grounded in our mission—to love, to serve, to witness. Without both movements—contemplation and action—our faith becomes unbalanced. So, we live in this dynamic tension: always looking to heaven, even as we remain faithful to the work we've been given here on earth.
