We can easily fall into the trap of reducing our faith - practically speaking, at least - to a kind of 'self-help' regime. Certainly, we will find much in the wisdom tradition, the practices, and the values of the Catholic Church that will help us to live the best kind of life and to be the best kind of people we can be. Important though that is,

faith calls us beyond such realities to something more transcendent. Indeed, the primary objective of our lives is to be 'priests of creation', offering a hymn of praise to God.

In his letter to the Colossians, St Paul includes what many scholars believe to be an early Christian hymn. Its focus is not on us, but on Christ himself. More to the point, it sums up the very purpose of creation as centred on Christ. Through Christ, the whole universe becomes a song of praise to the Father. And by reconciling all things (including ourselves), God's perfect plan is fulfilled in Him.

To believe in the perfection of God's plan takes more faith than to believe that Jesus rose from the dead! We, and the things of this world, are clearly lacking in perfection. We walk as broken people through a broken world. However, this is not the kind of perfection that is being spoken about. Christ is perfect precisely because he overcomes and transcends the very worst of the brokenness of our world. His life, then, is a 'hymn of praise' to the Father. We too can, through Christ, share in this perfection, offering our lives as a living hymn of praise. Here we sing not only words of blessing but also groans of lament, all offered through Christ to the glory of God the Father.


## MOM Parish Messages.....

Have you entered your birthday in our Parish Birthday Book?




