We simply pour a little water over the head of the person (often an infant) being baptised and proclaim the necessary words: "I baptise you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." This is all perfectly fine - and, in the end, practical. However, it misses some of the drama of the moment!



When Jesus was baptised - the origin and archetype of all Christian baptisms - he was plunged into the murky depths of the Jordan, and, immersed into the chaos of the waters entered into a place wholly incompatible with human life. This is appropriate, because it is death that is signified by this action. Baptism is a death to self, so as to become alive in Christ.


Hence, in St Paul's letter to the Colossians, he states: "You have been buried with Christ when you were baptised." We share symbolically in his death, but in an exceedingly wonderful exchange, we share actually in his Resurrection - with our sin wiped away and communion with the Father restored! (Cf. St Leo the Great Sermon 71).

So complete is this transaction that when the Church speaks of baptism, it speaks of the death of the old person, so that the one who emerges from the waters is "a new creature" (cf. CCC 1214).

For practical reasons, it makes sense to baptise in the aforementioned restrained way. Nevertheless, the meaning remains the same: we are baptised into the death of Christ, so as to emerge from the waters of death as new creatures, part of God's new creation. Let us truly live, therefore, as sons and daughters of God, dead to sin and alive to Grace.


### **GOSPEL REFLECTION GROUP**
