For many in our society, faith would be defined as the irrational belief in unseen and unprovable things. Faith is by no means irrational, but it certainly relates to those things unseen or only partially seen. This weekend's second reading, from the Letter to the Hebrews, points to this reality: "Only faith can guarantee the blessings that we hope for or Fr Michael Gre prove the existence of the realities that at present remain unseen."



Faith here is the guarantee precisely because the things we hope for are not merely rational but rather super-rational. They cannot be known by reason alone but require revelation. Such things are not secured by knowledge in the usual sense, but rather by faith, inspired by the rich hope we have in God's blessing and providence. The greatest example of such super-rational hope is our longing for, and anticipation of, a share in the eternal life of God when we arrive at long last in our heavenly homeland.

Later this week we celebrate the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This great feast is one of the most solemn days in the Church's life. As such. it is a 'holy day of obligation', similar to a Sunday, and so all Catholics are called upon to attend Mass. Its high status and importance are twofold: it points to our love and reverence for Mary and her importance in our lives and faith, as an exemplar of the hope that leads to eternal life; and it gives us the opportunity to grow in that same hope. Where she, following her Son, has gone before us, we too are destined to follow—if we likewise follow her example of faith.

Please be aware of the Assumption Mass times and note the changes to the usual parish weekday schedule.


